Fact Sheet Committee on Corporate Reform

The ad hoc Committee on Corporate Reform has been formed to make recommendations on the changes in our governance and leadership structures needed to:

- Comply with District of Columbia law for non-profits
- Address organizational stress and strengthen our effectiveness
- Achieve the goals of the ambitious APS Strategic Plan
- Ensure that APS remains the pre-eminent physics society

In November, Council passed a resolution that allows us to continue to use our current Constitution and By-Laws until our new structures are in place.

The ad hoc Committee on Corporate Reform (CCR) consists of the 8 elected Council Members who serve on the E-Board, the members of the Presidential Line and one ad hoc member, Cherry Murray who is the new Chair of the Committee on Constitution and By-Laws and a former APS President. APS legal counsel, Michael Cutler of Covington & Burling, LLP, also assists the CCR.
